


Creating a GitHub Site for Sharing Data

1. Go to www.github.com and create an account.
2. Click “New repository”.



Call the “Repository name” something like “Data”. Make it Public and initialize the repository with a README.





3. Click “Create new file”



Type docs/index.md in the box that says “Name your file...” Click “Commit new file”.



4. Click Settings. Under “GitHub Pages”, select “master branch/docs folder”.





5. If you want to create sub-folders, click “Create new file” and type the folder name. For example, to add a folder titled “Chapter1”, click “Create new file” and type “Chapter1/index.md” in the box. Click “Commit new file”.



6. To upload files to the new “Chapter1” folder, click “Upload files”. Select the files to upload and click “Commit changes”.
